- More than 270 oxygen concentrators presented to State Government
- Presented 500 corrugated beds to State Government for Radhaswami Satsangh Bhawan, Beelwa covid care center

POLICY ADVOCACY

REPRESENTATIONS SUBMITTED TO STATE GOVT

- **To stop migration of Labour, CII has recommended that all Industries including construction activities to be allowed to be operate with all SOPs in place during lockdown so that migration of workers can be stopped. Industries who can reside workers in their premises, move workers through their own vehicles or give company passes to workers can be allowed**
- **Deputing Medical Teams with Ambulance in the Industrial Areas or at RIICO offices in Industrial Areas wherever applicable will be a welcome step both for COVID testing & vaccination so that there is minimum movement of labour**
- **Banking Industry should be considered as Covid Warriors**
- **Tourism sector should be awarded Industry status**
- **As NBFCs are also a financial activity just like Banks they should be allowed to open**
- **As few migrant labour have started moving out and the raw material cost has increased tremendously, Completion dates of the projects need to be reconsidered and extended without liquidated damages and with price variation by atleast 6 months or till such time the fear of COVID-19 is over. There are many Govt projects of DISCOMS, Prasaran Nigam, RIICO, PWD, RSRDC, PHED, Warehousing Corporation which are time bound and penalty will be there if the project is not completed in time. We request that immediate extension to such projects be given so that there is no penalty on the industry/ contractor.**
- **CII has requested Govt to start vaccination of 18 plus at industry premises as was done for 45 plus staff**
- **To release pending payments of MSMEs specially JVVNL as these are stuck from November 2020**

Demand for oxygen grows, but supply hits roadblock

Against Need Of 795MT, O₂ Tankers Can Carry Only 430MT

Jaipur: Demand for oxygen continued to rise reaching 795MT even as supply remained at 366MT between May10-15. The additional allocated supply from Burnpur and Kalinganagar (1,347km & 1,746km respectively from Jaipur) is not helping the cause as there are not enough tankers to carry the capacity from the far off locations.

Terming the situation extremely fragile, the chief minister on Friday had urged the Centre for allotment of more imported oxygen at the earliest and also brought to notice the constraints in lifting 100MT from Burnpur and Kalinganagar.

While, the government is tapping all the avenues to increase production to 500 MT from its own end by July 15, there is an urgency to tide over the current crisis. "We have been allotted

CII donates 148 O₂ concentrators

After providing 500 beds for Radhasoami Satsang Bhawan Covid facility at Beelwa, members of the CII-Rajasthan have donated 148 oxygen concentrators to the state government to ease the crisis. Nitin Gupta, head, CII-Rajasthan, said they are facilitating oxygen plants at various locations in Rajasthan. The industry body also started free food service for 500 people at RUHS on a daily basis. **TNN**

After the state said that it is unable to lift the full allotted capacity of 100MT from Burnpur and Kalinganagar, the Centre allotted 40MT from Hazira in Gujarat, but senior officials in the medical health department said it was not enough.
