Its state offices are working at the grass-root level to facilitate industries and work toward relief and rehabilitation. It's working along with the state governments through representations/ recommendations at the highest level. Here are the interventions by the following states:

1. East and North East
2. Gujarat
3. Maharashtra



East and North East Region

Policy Advocacy for Industry and Members' Engagement

On 04 April, CII Secretariat in the Eastern and North Eastern Region received 10 issues from industry members. Representations were made in various Government departments. Some of the key issues that have been resolved have been in the areas of:

1. Arrangement of vehicle and movement passes for member companies personnel.
2. Facilitating the resuming of operation of fish feed additive manufacturer
3. Enabling unloading of loaded trucks by facilitating necessary permits
4. Handling un-due harassments meted out to food store managers through timely police intervention

Relief and Rehabilitation Activities in the States

- **West Bengal-** 50 masks, 50 sanitizers, 250 ration Kits have been distributed at Raiganj & Makardaha.
Cooked food has been served to 500 daily wage workers and 13250 Kg Rice, 300 Kg Potato, 10000 kg Atta, 2000 kg Dal, 2000 kg Sattu have been distributed among 2164 migrant workers and daily wage earners
- **Chhattisgarh-** 10200 cooked food packets have been distributed to migrant workers in Raipur, Bilai and Durg.
500 ration Kits have been distributed (2100 kg rice, 75 kg pulse, 400 g salt, 400 kg flour) in Raipur
- **Odisha-** Cooked food has been served to 3000 slum dwellers at Paradip.
A 15 bed capacity hospital dedicated for COVID 19 has been set up in coordination with District Administration at at Jharsuguda in Odisha



- **Jharkhand-** Cooked food has been served among 6450 daily wage labour and 5000 masks and 800 ration kits have been distributed to the people from marginalized section across Jharkhand
- **Assam-** 13 metric ton rice has been distributed among 700 needy people
- **Sikkim-** Cooked food has been served to 50 labourers and ration kit has been served to 12 labourers
