

CII Western Region, since the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic has been working actively to provide relief and assistance to the district communities, government hospitals, municipal corporations, police department and railways, in addition to the vulnerable sections of the society including migrant workers and underprivileged individuals.



### **Government Notifications / Announcements**

### GOA

Prohibition / Restriction On Following Activities / Establishment / Facilities / Events Under Section 144 in North and South Goa Districts

Various activities / establishments / facilities / events shall be prohibited or restricted in the district of North Goa and South Goa Districts up to 7 AM on 24 May 2021. For more details, please click on the below links –

Public Health Department Order Capping of Fares for Patient Transport Ambulance, Basic Life Support Ambulance, Advanced Life Support Ambulance and Hearse Vans for COVID Duty

The Public Health Department ordered capping of fares for patient transport ambulance to Rs. 1,500 per call upto 10 kms and Rs. 50 per extra km above 10 kms and Rs. 25 per km return charges, basic life support ambulance to Rs. 2,000 per call upto 10 kms and Rs. 50 per extra km above 10 kms and Rs. 25 per km return charges, advanced life support ambulance to Rs. 4,000 per call upto 10 kms and Rs. 50 per extra km above 10 kms and Rs. 50 per extra km above 10 kms and Rs. 25 per km return charges, and hearse vans to charge Rs. 1,500 per call upto 10 kms and Rs. 25 per extra km above 10 kms and Rs. 12.50 per km return charges, for COVID duty as per the order issued by Additional Secretary (Health), Govt of Goa

### **GUJARAT**

### Declaring black fungal infection/ mucormycosis as an epidemic

The Gujarat government as per order dated 19/05/2021 declared the black fungal infection/ mucormycosis as an epidemic in the state under the Epidemic Diseases Act 1897. The government & private hospitals and medical colleges treating the black fungus disease will have to follow guidelines issued by the Union Health Ministry as well as Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) for screening, diagnosis and treatment. Few hospitals had been identified by Gujarat government for treating this disease. Few injections with their rates had been authorised by the government for treating black fungus.

#### **Extension of Night Curfew**

In an attempt to contain COVID-19 cases, the Gujarat government announced an extension to the ongoing night curfew in 36 cities from 8 pm to 6 am from 21 May till 28 May. Apart from essential services, other shops and establishments may operate business between 9 am to 3 pm in these cities.

### **MADHYA PRADESH**

Madhya Pradesh Government to provide aid of Rs 5 lakh to kin of government employees who died of COVID-19

The Madhya Pradesh government launched a scheme to provide financial assistance of Rs 5 lakh to the families of its employees who died of COVID-19. The schemes will be meant for all regular, daily wagers, contractual and outsourced employees who died due to the coronavirus infection and would be provided under the Mukhyamantri COVID-19 Vishesh Anugrah Yojana (for financial assistance to families of deceased employees) and the Mukhyamantri COVID-19 Anukampa Niyukti Yojana.

### Government of Madhya Pradesh to set up medical college in Ujjain

The Madhya Pradesh government tannounced to set up a new Medical College

in Ujjain. Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan during his visit to Ujjain directed officers to prepare a proposal to be sent to Central government for the same.

### Changes in Lockdown guideline in Indore district

Making changes to the previously issued guidelines, Indore District Administration released new guidelines on 20thMay and imposed a strict lockdown till 28thMay prohibiting even fruits/vegetable vendor, grocery shops on their movement. Grocery home delivery agencies (Bigbasket/on-door etc.) have been advised to make supplies with only two staff and warehouses are permitted to open at specified time limits only. However, industrial employees/staff have been permitted to travel to their offices with valid ID cards.

Virtual Interaction of Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Madhya Pradesh with CII Office Bearers & Corporate sector

A virtual interaction was organised with Shri Singh Chouhan, Hon'ble Chief Shivari Minister, Madhya Pradesh and CII office bearers & corporate sector on 20 May 2021to understand COVID 19 vaccination plan of Industry in Madhya Pradesh and seek other suggestion/support required from state towards the same. Along with the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Mr Sanjay Shukla IAS, Principal Secretary, Department of IP&IP, Govt. of MP, Mr B. Thiagrajan, Chairman, CII Western Region & Managing Director. Bluestar Ltd., Mr Sunil Chordia, Dy. Chairman, CII Western Region & Managing Director, Rajratan Global Wires Ltd. And Mr Saurabh Sangla, Chairman, Cll Madhya Pradesh & Executive Director, Adroit Industries (India) Ltd. were also present at the interaction.

Shri Chouhan informed that around one crore citizens have been vaccinated with atleast first dose of vaccines In Madhya Pradesh and the state government is working on a mission mode to vaccinate the rest of the citizens. He urged the corporate sector to come forward and explore on possibility of manufacturing COVID-19 vaccines in the state and appointed Mr Sanjay Shukla, Principal Secretary, Industries Department as the nodal officer for further co-ordination. The strict lockdown in Nashik district since 12 May 2021 has affected the consumer sentiment and disrupted the global supply as the industries were shut for the past 10 days. Members requested Dr Kamble to allow industry operations from the coming week without any restrictions. Dr Kamble assured that he will look into the matter and discuss the same with the District Collector of Nashik.

CII North Maharashtra zonal organised a meeting with Mr Suraj Mandhare, Collector, Nashik District on 21 May 2021 wherein industrial members requested the collector to allow industries to work from 24 May without restrictions anv as the manufacturing facilities were shut due to lockdown imposed by the district administration, thereby affecting the global supply chain. The District Collector accepted the suggestions given by members and mentioned that companies in the essential category will operate at full capacity, while remaining will operate with 50 per cent capacity from 24 May 2021. Mr Mandhare also urged that companies must arrange for pick-up and drop service.



### Taking Care of Sick People with COVID-19 Illness at Home

#### Having a Sick Person in the home



CI

Many people who get sick with coronavirus (COVID-19) can be safely cared for at home. If possible, have the sick person stay in one room, or physically away from other people in the household. Keep them at least 1 metre (an arm's length) away from others.

### Wearing a mask



Have the sick person wear a mask, or cloth face covering, when they are around other people, including family members. Caregivers should wear a mask, or cloth face covering, and disposable gloves when touching any items used by the sick person.

### Washing your hands

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds before and after caring for the sick person, before preparing and eating food, before and after wearing gloves, and after using the toilet.

### **Disinfect surfaces**



Clean frequently touched surfaces, or items in the house with soap and water every day. Then, use a diluted chlorine solution to disinfect.


