Government Announcements on COVID-19 (for Society)



GUJARAT

Sr No.	Announcement
1	Students from standard 1st-9th and 11th will be mass promoted and schools have been notified not to begin their new academic session post summer vacation instead of April
2	To ensure that daily essentials are easily available to people, Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC) urged vegetable vendors sell fruits and vegetables by moving around societies. Besides AMC will also source vegetables and deliver to societies with cumulative requirement of more than 100 kgs
3	In event of the employees and workers of public and private organisations and factories not reporting to duty, they should not be sacked and their entire salary/ wages should be remitted
4	AMC appealed to people in general that in the situation of lockdown, individuals/ families in providing food/ tiffin service to students/ individuals staying as paying guests/ independently, should come forward and get in touch with AMC to do the same

MADHYA PRADESH

Sr No.	Announcement
1	A sum of Rs 8.25 lakh has been approved to give financial aid of Rs 1,000 to each construction worker
2	Rs 600 would be given to 46 lakh pensioners every month across the state. A sum of Rs 275 crore has been sanctioned for the same.
3	A sum of Rs 156 crore will be deposited in the accounts of 65.91 lakh students for mid-day meals
4	In view of the covid calamity, the state government fixed the price of sanitiser at Rs 1,800 including GST for a box of 50 bottles of 180 ml each for government supply and maximum of Rs 2,100 for non-government supply/sale

Government launched temporary pass facility on Goa Online Portal in order to cater to the requirement of people who need immediate pass to travel short distances for the purpose of buying grocery, medicines and withdrawal of money from ATM

Online test and subject-wise online classes in mathematics and science will be conducted for class X students appearing in Board Examination April 2020 for all the Government and Govt-Aided Secondary by State Council of Educational Research & Training, Govt of Goa

Under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana Scheme, all the NFSA (AAY and PHH) ration card holders shall be given an additional quota of 5 kgs per person per month for a period of three months

4

Harvesting of paddy, vegetable, pulses, cashew, coconut and other crops has commenced in the state. To contain the spread of covid, government advised farmers to avoid engaging more labourers per day, engage only familiar persons in farm operations, sanitise farm implements, tractors, power tiller & transport vehicles, practice safety measures during post-harvest operations like drying, threshing, winnowing and packing, ensure proper drying of produce before storing to prevent pest infestation and take short duration vegetable crops during this summer.

Goa

- Inbound or outbound freight movement allowed for unit manufacturing packaging material used in essential goods
- Permission granted to resume production of medicines and also operate logistics to dispatch the same

Gujarat

- Approval given to operate plant supplying oxygen separators used in hospitals
- Permission to operate granted to agro and pesticides unit
- Food processing firm granted permission to move goods and dealers



- Packaging unit supplying to essential goods manufacturers granted permission for transit of employees

Madhya Pradesh

- Company manufacturing hospital furniture (ICU beds) granted permission to operate
- Unit manufacturing packaging materials for food grains for supplying to Madhya Pradesh Civil Supplies Corporation granted permission to operate.

Maharashtra

- Coal production and mining unit granted permission to move raw materials and also to operate warehouse
- Agro packaging company granted permission to operate
