ORDER

Under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1973.

WHEREAS, a fresh surge in COVID-19 cases is being witnessed in some parts of the country, and the situation might further aggravate due to social /religious/ sports/ entertainment/ educational/ cultural or any other form of gatherings,

AND WHEREAS, in order to contain the spread of the said pandemic, certain measures are required to be taken;

AND WHEREAS, it is essential to enforce social distancing of people to prevent the spread of the disease;

AND WHEREAS in my considered opinion, there is sufficient grounds for proceeding under sub section (1) of section 144 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 to take preventive steps to contain the spread of Virus.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Ajit Roy, IAS, District Magistrate, North Goa District, in exercise of the power vested in me under sub section (1) of section 144 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, do hereby impose the following restrictions/ban in North Goa District:

Social/ religious/sports/ entertainment/educational/ cultural or any other form of gatherings, shall be allowed subject to following limits:

- For halls of maximum capacity upto 100, gathering upto maximum of 50% of the hall capacity or a maximum of 50 persons whichever is lower, and;
- For halls with capacity of more than 100, gathering will be permissible upto 50% of its capacity or maximum of 100 persons, whichever is lower, and;
- For open premises and grounds, gathering upto 50% of its capacity or maximum gathering of people upto 200 persons, whichever is lower.


Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte.

This order shall come into force from 08/04/2021 superseding the Order No 8/8/2021-MAG/L&O/(VOL-I) dated 26/03/2021.
